#### Dr. Laura Schumann

Dr Laura E Schumann is Professor of Music and Music Director and Conductor of the Southeastern Ohio Symphony Orchestra. With a tenure of over 20 years at Muskingum, Schumann has taught classes from music history to pop music to conducting to recording. A certified sound and recording engineer, she is also a solo performer on electric violin/vocals/guitar/ukulele as Dr Laura's Musical Adventures and often performs in local eating establishments.

Originally from Colorado, Schumann received her DMA in orchestral conducting from Texas Tech University, a

Master's degree in violin performance from the University of California, Santa Barbara, and her Bachelor of Music degree in violin performance from the University of Colorado, Boulder.

Schumann conducts the Southeastern Ohio Symphony, a full symphony orchestra on campus as well as Muskie Rocks - a new pop/rock band playing events on and off campus. Schumann is a published composer and arranger, with her most popular tune being Charlie Daniel's "The Devil Went Down to Georgia" for full orchestra and a string orchestra reduction! She has won numerous awards, most notably the National Award for Adventurous Programming from ASCAP and an invitation-only grant from the National Endowment for the Arts. Both SEOSO and Schumann were awarded a Governor's Proclamation from Ohio Governor John Kasich on Schumann's 20th Anniversary season with SEOSO in 2018.

As a conductor, Schumann has held positions and guest conducted in Colorado, Missouri, Pennsylvania, Texas, Minnesota, Tennessee, West Virginia, California, Washington, and she has toured several European countries. She has conducted several high school festivals including Colorado All-State, West Virginia Honors Orchestra, Wyoming Honors Orchestra, and Ohio Region Honors Orchestras.

Schumann has performed as both soloist and chamber musician in various locations across the United States and in Taiwan, Hong Kong, Canada, Hungary, Austria, and the Czech Republic. Schumann has performed in the Colorado Music Festival, North Carolina, West Virginia, Key West, Wheeling, Charlotte, Memphis, Winston-Salem, Greensboro, and Lubbock Symphonies among others.

Schumann lives in Zanesville, is a certified trainer (horse whisperer) with Reach Out to Horses and has achieved the level of Usui Reiki Master (working with both animals and humans) in 2022.
